### The purpose of the Senate league...

- ◆ Improve your skills by challenging you both mentally and physically in a highly competitive & FUN atmosphere
- ◆ Gain confidence in your abilities while improving your game so that you can reach your personal goals

### What the program is about...

The Providence Senate Junior Program promotes sportsmanship, fellowship and friendship through encouragement, tutelage and guidance. In addition to bowling, the bowlers are given instructions in the basics of everyday living, such as: a sense of fair play in sports and daily habits, respect for others, leadership and honesty.

### More General Information...

The Providence Senate Junior Program is the only youth league in the state that is affiliated with both USBC & TNBA. This league is open to boys and girls ages 4 to 21 (as of Aug. 1, 2008) and bowls weekly on Sunday **AFTERNOONS** for 30 weeks at **1 P.M.** The cost is \$8/wk for bumper bowlers (which includes 2 games of bowling); and all other divisions are \$10/wk (bowls 3 games). Shoes are provided free of charge each week. All youths will receive a free league shirt. The Senate offers three divisions based on skill level (bumper for beginners, intermediate, and advance students). A one-time registration fee is required of \$25 per person (\$10 for bumpers) and this covers sanctioning memberships throughout the entire season. Pre-registration is on Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> from 1 to 4 p.m.

### When:

The league begins on Sunday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, and will bowl in a **New Time Slot of 1 p.m. each week.** If you have not already pre-registered, then it is suggested that you come early on the first day.
